

Community Youth Services is recruiting for a full-time Program Director for its Transitional Age Youth (TAY) program. This position will oversee a home and community based services program and is responsible for program outcomes and compliance through training, supervision, consultation, and tracking in a team-based way. In addition, this position is tasked with implementing the program model in a way that successfully adapts services to best meet the needs of Transitional Age Youth while utilizing Evidence-Based and Research-Informed Practices. This position works closely with the Clinical Director on program development. This position requires driving throughout Thurston and Mason counties. \$4,533 - \$4,660 monthly

- Experience in a community Behavioral Health/Mental Health agency
